

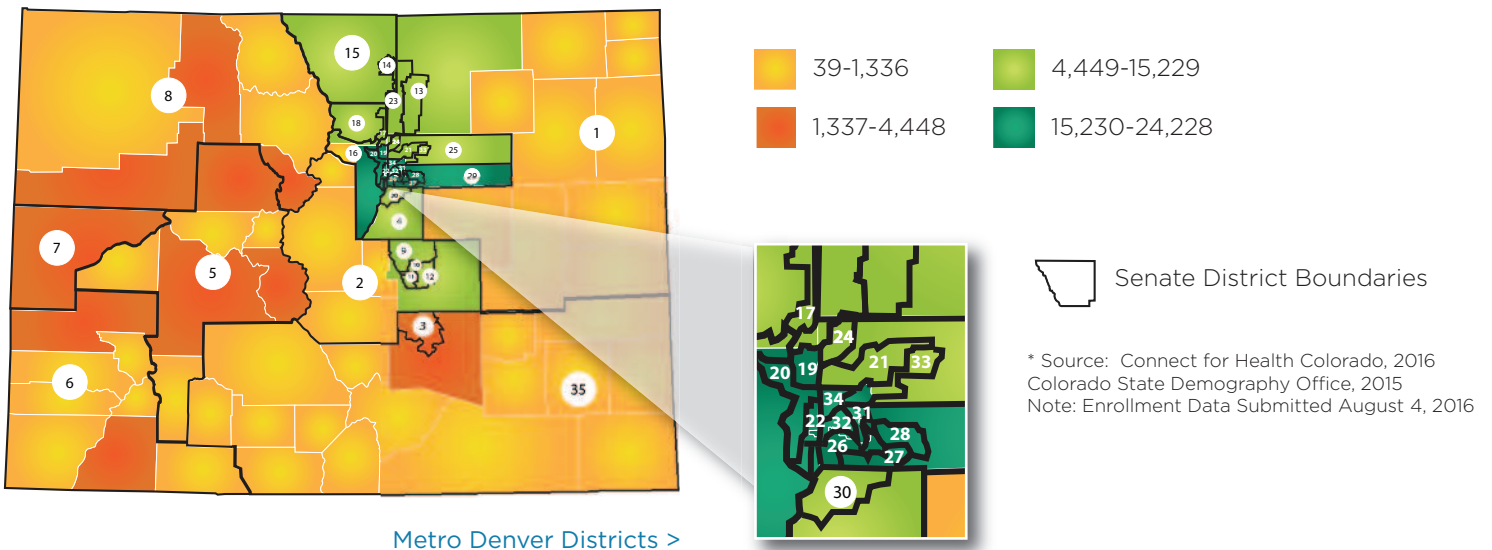


Covering Your Constituents

Connect for Health Colorado's mission is to increase affordability, access, and choice to individuals, families, and small businesses purchasing health insurance in Colorado. During the third Open Enrollment Period, more than 169,000 Coloradans enrolled in coverage. This Open Enrollment Period resulted in increases in many key metrics compared to last year, making it our strongest performance to date. While we are the only place for Coloradans to access the Advanced Premium Tax Credit (APTC) to help eligible customers pay down their monthly premium, we are just one way for residents to access health insurance coverage.

According to the 2015 Colorado Health Access Survey, Colorado's uninsured rate plummeted from 14.3% in 2013 to 6.7% in 2015. As one way to access health insurance coverage in Colorado, Connect for Health Colorado is proud to have a role in reducing the State's uninsured rate. This document was developed as a resource to help you better understand the number of Coloradans enrolled in coverage through the Marketplace and the uninsured rate in the counties you represent.
