Position Summary:

The Security Analyst will work alongside the Privacy and Security Officer performing multiple functions as part of the security and privacy program. They will regularly interface with internal business leaders, service providers, state and federal partners, brokers, carriers, assistance sites, and others. This individual will be expected to stay informed of evolving regulations, threats, risks, technology, and recognized best practices.

Position Responsibilities:

- Manage information security incidents, coordinate response, investigate privacy complaints.
 - Evaluate overall Privacy and Security functions and recommend enhancements or changes.
 - Review and update security and privacy documentation including system security plans, privacy impact assessments, corrective action plans, security policies.
 - Review vulnerability scans and work with service providers on remediation.
 - Perform security and privacy risk assessments as required.
 - Support business projects by performing security and privacy due diligence.
 - Interact and propose solutions to managers on operations and processes that are impacted by the privacy and security of information.
 - Assess new technologies to determine potential value in the areas of privacy and security.
 - Participate in the Company Technology Change Management process; help review and approve changes.
 - Assess new security threats and vulnerabilities and make recommendations on appropriate avoidance and mitigation strategies.

- BA/BS in a Business related field and/or equivalent years of experience working with and understanding the health insurance market.
- Current certification: CISSP, Security +, or similar preferred.
- Two + years Information Security, Enterprise IT operations, or privacy/security consulting
- Experience with creation and implementation of FISMA or HIPAA compliant programs.

- Breadth of experience working in organizations across a spectrum of life-cycle stages including: start-ups, established, steady-state organizations; and organizations in transition.
